*The photo on the right has **too much contrast**: The brights are too bright (blown highlights) and the dark areas lose important detail.*

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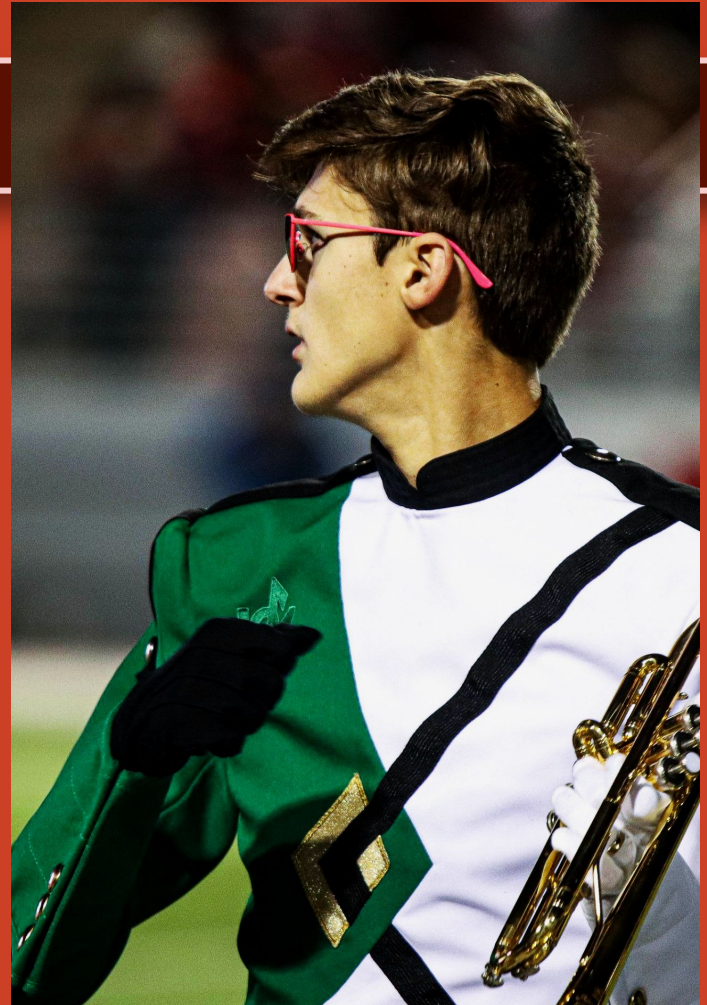

YOU SHOULD HAVE LEARNED

- 1. Crop from the face out.*
- 2. Avoid distracting mergers like cropping at joints.*
- 3. Color correct using Color Balance.*
- 4. Exposure correct using Levels.*
- 5. Edit color & exposure to the main subject's skin*
